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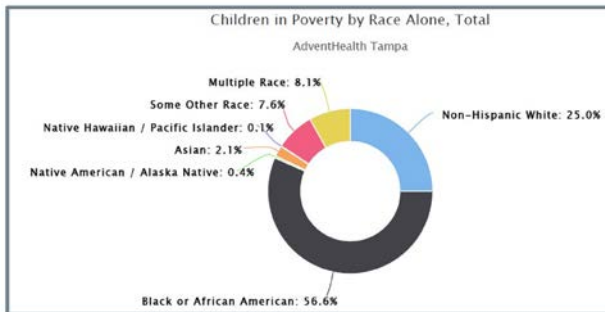

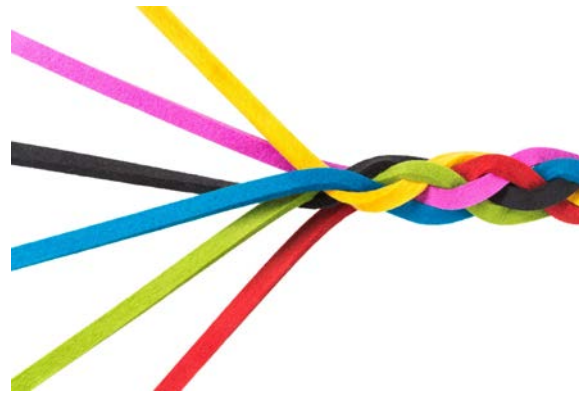
Neighborhood Information for Zip Codes 33610 & 33605

- Over 1.4 million people call Hillsborough County home
- Top 3 Health Priorities as reported in the 2019 Community Needs Assessment by Tampa General Hospital and BayCare Health System :
 - Behavioral Health
 - Access to Health Services & Exercise
 - Nutrition & Weight
- Zip codes 33610 & 33605 were the highest ranked ones according to the SocioNeeds Index based on six social risk factors (poverty, economy, education, language, income and occupation).

Key Programs at Dr. Traci's House:

- Medical and Behavioral health clinic for pediatric and adult populations
- Daycare and early childhood education including sick daycare
- Commercial kitchen with nutritional support for daycare, clinic and community residents
- Pediatric and adult dental, vision and pharmaceutical services
- Strategic partnership with local health professional schools for onsite training and apprenticeship
- Health technology hub for community data collection of social health needs
